Invitation combined BWF/BEC Level 1 and Level 2 Coach Education course for (former) players

Dear Member Association,

Badminton Europe is happy to inform you that we will organise a combined BWF/BEC Level 1 and Level 2 Coach Education Course for (former) players. We are doing this in close cooperation with the Polish Badminton Federation. The course is open to former players but also players who have ambitions to become a coach in the future.

The objectives of the combined BWF/BEC Level 1 and Level 2 Coach Education Course for former players are:

- To educate former players to coaches to utilise their skills and experience that they have acquired in their active careers.

Prerequisites for participants:

- Must have been a top 150 player on the world ranking.
- Speak English on an intermediate level.

Planning

The course will be held from 13-19 November 2020 in Warsaw, Poland.

The course will start early in the morning on Friday 13 November 2020 and finish on Thursday 19 November 2020 at 12:00.

Participants are expected to arrive on Thursday 12 November 2020 and depart Friday 20 November 2020 in the afternoon.

- 8 lunches and 8 dinners

Travel costs for the participants will not be covered by Badminton Europe. Travel related costs have to be covered by Member Associations or participants.
