Re: Seeking host for 2020 European Junior Championships

Dear Members,

Please be informed that currently we have no organizer anymore to host the 2020 European Junior Championships.

The event was originally allocated to the Polish Badminton Association, but unfortunately they informed Badminton Europe on 22 June 2020 that they were not able to host the event anyway.

We therefore ask you to consider organizing the event. Some basis information and requirements are:

Number of players	300-350
Number of hotel nights	2.000-3.000
Dates	October-November 2020 (preferably 30 October – 8 November)
Days of competition	10 days
Number of courts	6 courts
Number of training courts	4 courts

The main expenses to organize the event are:

- Transport between airport and hotels and between hotels and venue
- Venue
- Accommodation and allowance for technical officials

The competition set up will be provided by YONEX and Badminton Europe (except for umpire chairs).

The number of players, coaches and family members coming to the event and nights spent in hotels are high and therefore the event has a clear tourism value for the host city. This might allow you as potential organizer to make a good cooperation and support agreements with the hosting city and hotel partners.
