Event:

- U 9 – born 2011 or later – MS, WS
- U 11 – born 2009 or later– MS, WS, MD and WD
- U 13 – born 2007 or later – MS, WS, MD and WD
- U 15 – born 2005 or later – MS, WS, MD, WD and XD

NOTE:

- A player can participate in a maximum of three events regardless of age group: one singles, one doubles and one mixed doubles
- If a player participates in both tournaments, Zagreb U17 Open and Zagreb Youth Open, tournaments are counted as one.

Playing system:

- U9, U11 – Singles events will be played in Groups (3-4); 2Q to K.O.
- U13, U15 – Singles events will be played in Groups (3-4); 1Q to K.O.
- U11, U13, U15 – All Doubles events will be played in K.O. System

Entries:

All entries must be emailed on official entry form to: silvio@badminton-zagreb.hr

Entree fees:

- Singles – 15 EUR
- Doubles – 10 EUR per player per event

The Member Association that enters a player/pair into a tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but cash payments will be accepted at tournaments.

Visa:

After entering a player(s) in the tournaments it is the Member Nation's responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed. Member Associations must make sure that visa applications are made early enough.

If you need visa for Croatia please ask for the official Invitation letter as soon as possible.

1 (or 2) best player per country by national ranking will get seedings.

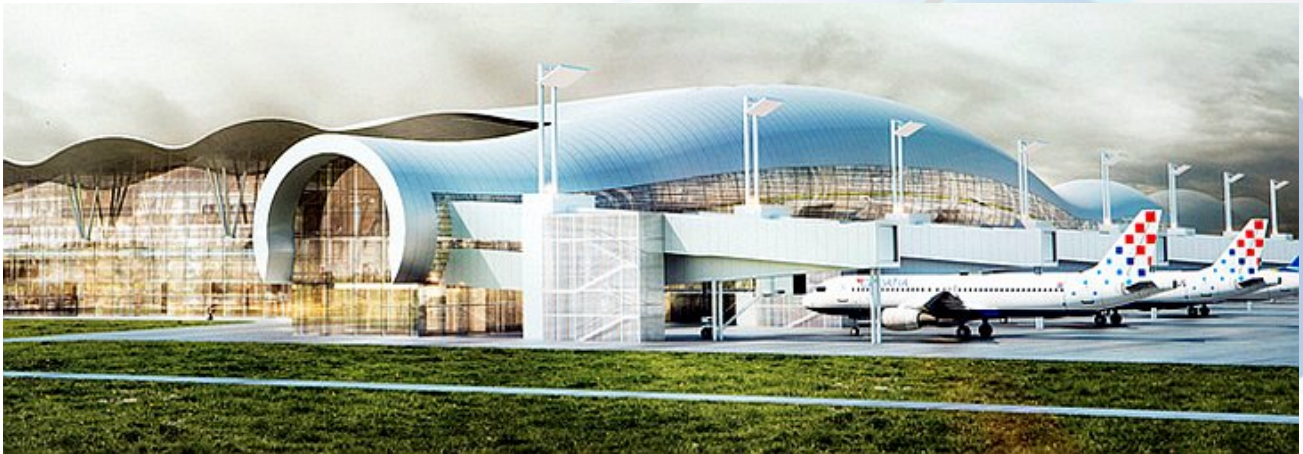


Local transport:
